

Impacts of the John L. Pitts Aquatic Veterinary Education Awards Program on Aquatic Veterinary Medicine

Since 2010, \$42,500 has been awarded to 65 veterinary students and newly graduated veterinarians to expand their education and involvement in aquatic veterinary medicine. Over that period, more than 230 applications have been received.
