

WAVMA STUDENT CHAPTER MINI-GRANT

- APPLICATION FORM -

A limited number of WAVMA Student Chapter Mini-Grants of up to 500 USD are available to assist official WAVMA Student Chapters with conducting activities intended to engage students in opportunities related to aquatic veterinary medicine.

Activities planned between 1st January and 30th June must have applications submitted by 30th November of the previous year.

Activities planned between 1st July and 31st December must have applications submitted by 31st May.

This completed form and one letter of recommendation from an Academic Advisor, who approved the activity intended for funding, must be submitted exclusively via email by the above deadlines, directly to the WAVMA Education & Students Committee (ESC@wavma.org)

WAVMA Student Chapters are not eligible for the Mini-Grant if they received funding during the previous application cycle. Applications will be evaluated by the WAVMA Education & Students Committee on the:

- 1) educational and scientific merits of the proposal to engage students in opportunities related to aquatic veterinary medicine
- 2) feasibility of conducting the activity supplemented with the Mini-Grant
- 3) number of students that will participate

All applicants will be notified about awards within 30-days after each application deadline.

Awardees are required to submit an activity report to be published in *The Aquatic Veterinarian* within 30 days after the activity completion.
